

This can be a 4-7 week series of Bible memory, with 7 craft projects:

- a book with the entire chapter (pages 26-29), a trumpet (verse 3a - page 30),
- a harp/strings (verses 3b, 4b - page 31), a tambourine (verse 4a - page 32), a flute (verse 4b - page 33),
- cymbals (verse 5 - page 34), a balloon person (verse 6 - page 35).

You may also use this opportunity to introduce musical instruments to the children by bringing musicians in (child or adult) to show and play different instruments.

Compile a book of Psalm 150. Cut out the 14 illustrated pages (inc. cover page). Cut 2 pieces of 9"x12" construction paper in half, making 4 pieces, each 9"x6". Place the 4 pieces together. Fold in half. Staple together in fold (2 staples), forming 4-1/2"x6" book.

Glue cover page (Psalm 150) on front page. LEAVE INSIDE FRONT COVER BLANK. Glue on remaining pages, in order. Outside back cover will also be blank. Color. Optional: Glue cotton on clouds (verse 1).

Use hand motions for verses 1-2.

"Praise the Lord": Point upward.

"Praise God in his sanctuary": Clasp hands together (fingers entwined), with index fingers straight up, forming steeple. ("This is the church, this is the steeple,...")

"Praise him in his mighty heavens": Raise both arms up toward heaven.

"Praise him for his acts of power": Make muscles with both arms.

"Praise him for his surpassing greatness": With hands raised, bow forward from waist two times, as though bowing to a king.

Make the other craft projects for verses 3-6. Play each instrument as you say it; dance on vs. 4....

MEMORY NOTES: "Praise GOD" only 1st time -- all others are "Praise HIM". "Praise him IN" (where) 2x; then "Praise him FOR" (why) 2x; then all the rest are "Praise him WITH" (how).
