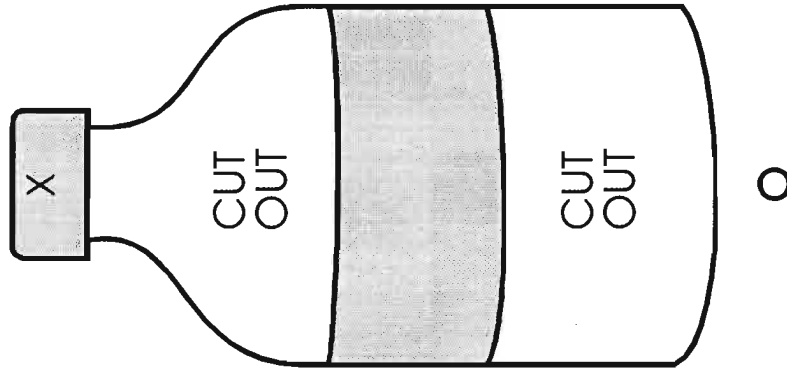


**"A joyful heart

dries up the bones."**

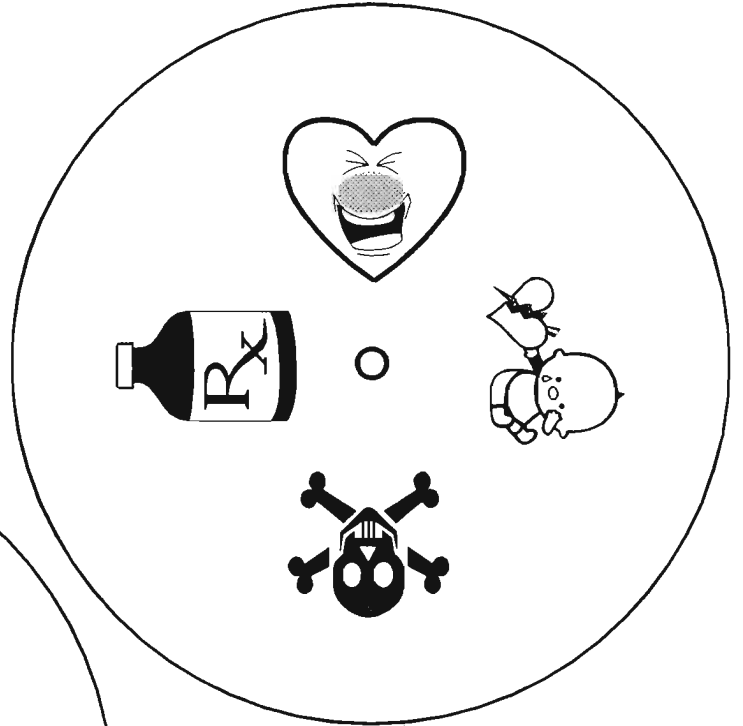
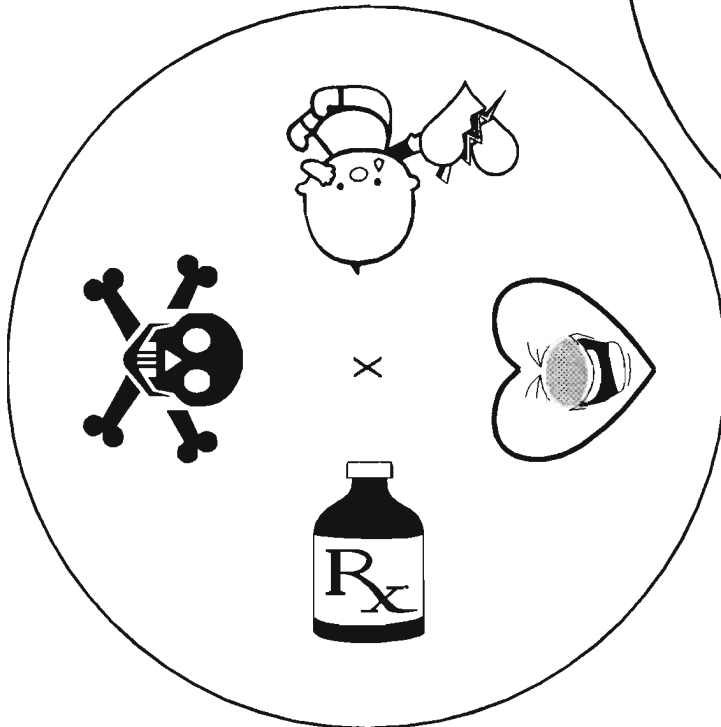


Proverbs 17:22

As you say the verse, turn both wheels to show pictures for "a joyful heart" "is good medicine"; turn wheels again to show pictures for "a broken spirit" "dries up the bones."

Have fun mixing them up the wrong way. ("A broken spirit is good medicine"; "Dried-up bones make you laugh"; "Medicine makes you cry",) Always make sure, however, that you know how to say it the correct way!



Color. Cut across vertical line. Cut out 2 picture wheels. Cut out 2 sections in medicine bottle, where indicated. With picture wheels underneath, match up X with X and O with O; fasten with paper fasteners.
