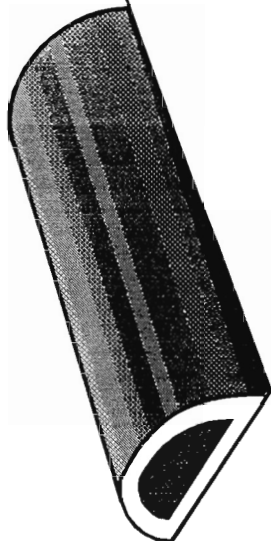


TAPE THIS EDGE

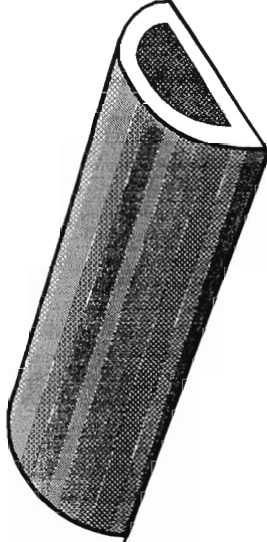
Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.



# Matthew 6:19-21

TAPE THIS EDGE

But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.



For where your treasure is, there your heart will also be.

PAGE 1 OF 2. Cut out the 3 pieces above (heart and the 2 treasure chest lids with words). Mount heart on red construction paper cut into same pattern (optional). On page 2, cut out slits along hinge on both chests. (Heart will be placed in slits.) Line up lids on treasure chests and tape only along top edge of each lid flap, as indicated. Lift each flap to see treasures as you say verses 19 and 20. As you say verse 21, place heart into slit in chest of treasures you value most.

Make earthly treasure rusty by lightly spreading glue on earthly treasure chest. Sprinkle cinnamon (or any brown spice) over glue. Lightly spread glue on cloud, Jesus, and rays around Jesus. Apply small pieces of cotton to blank portions of cloud. Sprinkle glitter on Jesus' clothes and rays.

For younger children, you may want to read first 2 verses as they lift flaps, and have them memorize only verse 21. Or you may want to eliminate lid flaps if only teaching verse 21. (Only cut out heart and slits.)
